The Department of Financial Services is seeking Attorneys to work directly with the agency's Executive Deputy Superintendent for Enforcement and other top executive staff in the investigation and resolution of enforcement matters across the Department. Each attorney position will focus on significant and complex enforcement matters, including in the Banking, Insurance, and Real Estate Finance Divisions of the Department. Responsibilities may include coordination of enforcement matters involving the Capital Markets and Consumer Protection Divisions. Responsibilities also include managing enforcement matters, involving such tasks as taking testimony, conducting witness interviews, document review and analysis, legal research, drafting memoranda of law and/or reports, and correspondence and other communications pertaining to enforcement, legal and policy issues, and providing updates to the Superintendent and other senior staff. Positions may involve oversight of monitors in place at various regulated institutions. Attorneys will also be expected to oversee the work of more junior attorneys and staff in their work on enforcement matters.

Qualifications:

Admission to the Bar of the State of New York and at least three years of experience in the practice of law involving civil or criminal litigation and/or regulatory work. Candidates should possess developed organizational skills and the ability to manage large and complex investigations.
