WHEREAS, Respondent United Healthcare Insurance Company of New York is a domestic accident and health insurance company authorized to do business in this state pursuant to Article 42 of the New York Insurance Law ("Insurance Law"); and

WHEREAS, an examination of Respondent conducted by the New York State Insurance Department for the period January, 2008 through December, 2009 revealed that the Respondent did not provide acceptable written notice to certain contract holders of the availability of certain mental health benefits under "Timothy's Law" (Chapter 748 of the Laws of 2006, as amended by Chapter 502 of the Laws of 2007); and

WHEREAS, Respondent has been advised and is aware of its statutory right to notice and a hearing on any possible violations; and

WHEREAS, Respondent wishes to resolve this matter by entering into a Stipulation with the New York State Department of Financial Services ("Department") on the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth in lieu of proceeding with a hearing; **NOW THEREFORE**,

IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED by and between the Respondent and the Department, subject to the approval of the Superintendent of Financial Services, as follows:

1. Respondent waives its right to further notice and a hearing in this matter and admits that during calendar years 2008 and 2009, Respondent United Healthcare Insurance Company of New York did not provide acceptable written notice to certain group contract holders of the availability of coverage for adults and children with biologically based mental illness and for children with serious emotional disturbances under Sections 4303(g)(4)(A) and 4303(h)(4)(A) of the Insurance Law and Section 3221(l)(5)(D)(i) of the Insurance Law.
