106th Federal Act of May 15, 1946 Concerning the Annulment of Legal Transactions and other Legal Acts during the German Occupation of Austria.

The National Council (“*Nationalrat*”) has passed the following bill:

Sec. 1. Legal transactions for or without a consideration and other legal acts during the German occupation of Austria shall be null and void if they were made in the course of the political or commercial penetration of the country by the German Reich in order to withdraw from natural or legal persons any assets or property rights to which they were entitled on March 13, 1938.

Sec. 2. The type of assertion and the scope of the claims resulting from Section 1 hereof shall be governed by a Federal Act.

Sec. 3. The enforcement of this Federal Act shall be entrusted to the Federal Ministry for Asset Protection and Economic Planning (“*Bundesministerium für Vermögenssicherung und Wirtschaftsplanung*”) in agreement with all federal ministries involved.
