TO: ALL INSURERS LICENSED TO WRITE AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE IN NEW YORK STATE

RE: CIRCULAR LETTER NO. 1 (1980) AND AMENDMENTS NOS. 1 & 2 MOTOR VEHICLE LIABILITY INSURANCE PREMIUM REDUCTION FOR COMPLETION OF ACCIDENT PREVENTION COURSE PURSUANT TO SECTION 2336 OF THE INSURANCE LAW

It has come to the attention of this Department that many insurers have not updated the list of Motor Vehicle Accident Prevention Course Sponsors mailed to insureds in accordance with the subject circular letter.
