TO: ALL INSURERS AUTHORIZED TO WRITE FIRE INSURANCE IN NEW YORK STATE

RE: HAZARDOUS MATERIAL REPORT FORMS
SECTION 168-i OF THE INSURANCE LAW
SECTION 209-u OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW
