**FIRST AMENDMENT TO REGULATION NO. 19
(11 NYCRR 45)**

APPLICATIONS FOR LIFE INSURANCE

I, Gregory V. Serio, Superintendent of Insurance of the State of New York, pursuant to the authority granted by Sections 201, 301, 3203 and 4510 of the Insurance Law, do hereby promulgate the following First Amendment to Part 45 of Title 11 of the Official Compilation of Codes, Rules and Regulations of the State of New York (Regulation No. 19), to take effect upon publication in the State Register, to read as follows:

The statutory authority references for Part 45 are repealed and a new statutory authority is added to read as follows:

Insurance Law Sections 201, 301, 3203 and 4510

Section 45.1 is amended to read as follows:

§45.1 Notice of war restrictions.

Pursuant to section [21] 301, section [155 (as last amended by chapter 730 of the Laws of 1951)] 3203, and section [458] 4510 of the Insurance Law [(as last amended by chapter 114 of the Laws of 1952)], all companies writing policies subject to the provisions of section [155] 3203 with respect to policies issued [on and after August 30, 1957] for delivery in New York State, and all fraternal benefit societies writing certificates subject to the provisions of section [458] 4510 with respect to certificates issued [on or after January 1, 1953] for delivery in New York State which contain war restrictions, are instructed to insert in their application forms a notice that war restrictions will be included in such policy or certificate.
