**SECOND AMENDMENT TO REGULATION NO. 104  
(11 NYCRR 87)**

**INSURER NAME APPROVAL**

I, Gregory V. Serio, Superintendent of Insurance of the State of New York, pursuant to the authority granted by Sections 201, 301, 1102(d), 1102(g), and 1201 of the Insurance Law, do hereby promulgate the following Second Amendment to Part 87 of Title 11 of the Official Compilation of Codes, Rules and Regulations of the State of New York (Regulation No. 104) to take effect upon publication in the State Register, to read as follows:

The statutory authority references for Part 87 are repealed and a new statutory authority is added to read as follows:

Insurance Law Sections 201, 301, 1102(d), 1102(g), and 1201

Subdivision (a) of Section 87.1 is amended to read as follows:

(a) The name of any proposed domestic insurance corporation, the name of any foreign or alien insurer seeking to be licensed in this State, and the proposed name, of any insurer seeking to change its name shall be submitted to the [Bureau of Corporate Affairs] Office of General Counsel, New York State Insurance Department, Agency Building One, Empire State Plaza, Albany, NY 12257.
