I, Gregory V. Serio, Superintendent of Insurance of the State of New York, pursuant to the authority granted by Sections 201, 301, 2304, 2315, 2331, 2332, 2333, and 2334 of the Insurance Law, do hereby promulgate the following First Amendment to Parts 140, 141, 142, 143, and 144 of Title 11 of the Official Compilation of Codes, Rules and Regulations of the State of New York (Regulation No. 32-A) to take effect upon publication in the State Register.

(Matter in brackets is deleted; new matter is underlined)

The statutory authority references for Part 140 are repealed and a new statutory authority is added to read as follows:

Insurance Law Sections 201, 301, 2304, 2315, 2331, 2332, 2333, and 2334

The statutory authority references for Part 141 are repealed and a new statutory authority is added to read as follows:

Insurance Law Sections 201, 301, 2304, 2315, 2331, 2332, 2333, and 2334

The statutory authority references for Part 142 are repealed and a new statutory authority is added to read as follows:

Insurance Law Sections 201, 301, 2304, 2315, 2331, 2332, 2333, and 2334

The statutory authority references for Part 143 are repealed and a new statutory authority is added to read as follows:

Insurance Law Sections 201, 301, 2304, 2315, 2331, 2332, 2333, and 2334

The statutory authority references for Part 144 are repealed and a new statutory authority is added to read as follows:

Insurance Law Sections 201, 301, 2304, 2315, 2331, 2332, 2333, and 2334

Section 141.4(d) is amended to read as follows:

(d) Nonfleet tractor and semitrailer combination units shall be classified at least by distance categories and such units that are a part of a fleet shall be classified as such. The exposure for such combination units shall be the number of tractors, and losses shall be assigned to the classification of the power unit involved in the accident. [For example, carriers for which the commercial car rating system is that contained in the Automobile Casualty Manual published by the National Bureau of Casualty Underwriters (as of January 1, 1951) would provide classifications as shown in Appendix 2.]

Appendix 2 of Part 141 is hereby repealed.
