**SIXTH AMENDMENT TO REGULATION NO. 90
(11 NYCRR 218)**

**PROHIBITION OF GEOGRAPHICAL REDLINING IN WRITING PRIVATE
PASSENGER AUTOMOBILE AND FIRE OR FIRE AND EXTENDED COVERAGE
INSURANCE POLICIES**

I, Gregory V. Serio, Superintendent of Insurance of the State of New York, pursuant to the authority granted by Sections 201, 301, 307, 308, 3429, 3430, 3433, and Article 24 of the Insurance Law, do hereby promulgate the following Sixth Amendment to Part 218 of Title 11 of the Official Compilation of Codes, Rules and Regulations of the State of New York (Regulation No. 90), to take effect on upon publication in the State Register, to read as follows:

(Matter in brackets is deleted; new matter is underlined)

Subdivisions (a) and (c) of Section 218.5 are repealed, and subdivisions (b) and (d) are relettered to be subdivisions (a) and (b), respectively.

Subdivision (c) of Section 218.6 is amended to read as follows:

(c) Any insurer found by the superintendent to be in violation of section [115-a, 115-b or] 3429, 3431(a), or 3433 of the Insurance Law shall be considered to be engaged in unfair methods of competition and unfair or deceptive acts or practices, and shall be subject to the provisions of article 24 of the Insurance Law.
